

# EARTH EXPLORE ADVENTURES TUITION FEES



**ROCKIES ADVENTURE:** We raft the mighty Shoshone River, ride mountain trails and spot wildlife in Grand Teton National Park, and canoe amidst lofty glacial peaks. On an expedition to Yellowstone, we learn the inside story of Old Faithful, and track Yellowstone's bison and wolves with expert naturalists. Near Thermopolis, we dig up dinosaur fossils with paleontologists, and soak in mineral hot springs used by Native Americans for thousands of years. 5-days \$1650 8-days \$2350

**COSTA RICA ADVENTURE:** We raft a wild river surrounded by toucans and other tropical creatures, and take a thrilling zipline to view the jungle from above. We stand steps from an endangered green sea turtle laying her eggs, horseback ride through the cloud forest, and take a motor launch through pristine tropical jungle inhabited by caiman, white faced monkeys, howler monkeys, and the three toed sloth. Throughout our adventure we stay in jungle lodges surrounded by incredible natural beauty, and are led by expert Naturalist Guides. 5-days \$1710 8-days \$2350

**ALASKA ADVENTURE:** Our Alaska Adventure is a journey into the heart of America's last true frontier. It takes us to the foot of the continent's highest peak, Mt. McKinley, and on a wildlife viewing trip in Denali National Park. We step onboard the Alaska Railroad for a thrilling ride, and cruise to view humpback whales and the glaciers of Kenai Fjords National Park. Finally, we meet native Alaskans at the Alaska Native Heritage Center, and share their culture. 5-days \$1710 8-days \$2350

**HAWAII ADVENTURE:** Hosted by science and cultural experts from the University of Hawaii, we journey to ancient temples to learn how Hawaiians once lived, snorkel colorful coral reefs, and visit the world's most active volcano, Kilauea. We step into the rainforest to view amazing plants and animals, gaze at the highest waterfall in the Pacific, take to the surf in an authentic outrigger canoe, and come to understand one of the most beautiful and fragile places on Earth. 6-days \$1710 8-days \$2395

**WASHINGTON, D.C.:** An exciting and important trip for every student. We visit famous monuments like the Lincoln Memorial, the Vietnam Memorial, and the Jefferson Memorial, view the Tomb of the Unknowns at Arlington National Cemetery, explore the workings of government on Capitol Hill, and enjoy the home of George Washington, Mt. Vernon. We also take time to have our pictures taken at the White House, and view spaceships and other treasures at the National Air and Space Museum. At the Ford Theater Museum we learn about Abraham Lincoln's life, and at the National Archives, view the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution. 3-5 days \$800-\$1650 including airfare.
