



**ADVENTURE AND EXPLORATION IN THE ROCKIES**  
**Day to Day Travel Itinerary**

Huge mountains and world-renowned guides. We raft the mighty Snake River, spend amazing days in the shadow of the Grand Teton mountains, and learn about Old Faithful and Yellowstone's bison and wolves from expert naturalists. We camp under the stars in Yellowstone, canoe on a high mountain lake, and soar by cable car high over Jackson Hole.

**Day 1 Arrival Jackson**

Our adventure begins in Jackson, WY. Airport welcome by Teton Science School and Earth Explore. After dinner a group orientation by TSS staff.

**Day 2 Canoeing in the Tetons & Float Trip on the Snake**

After breakfast we set out for Grand Teton National Park, where we canoe at a high mountain lake, and picnic on its shore in the shadow of 13 thousand foot peaks. Here we learn about the glacial biomes of the Grand Tetons, the wonders of the Yellowstone Ecosystem, and the powerful geologic forces that created the Teton Range. After dinner, we enjoy a scenic float trip down the wild Snake River, to view beavers, elk and moose in their natural habitats.

**Day 3 Trail Ride and Soar to the Peak of Jackson Hole**

Incredible views await as we climb on horseback for a trail ride along the Teton Range. Above us towers Grand Teton peak at over 13 thousand feet, and high hanging glacial valleys. Today we picnic in Grand Teton National Park before departing for Teton Village. Here we board the famous Jackson Hole Aerial Tram for a trip to 10,450 feet, with a once-in-a-lifetime view of Jackson Hole spread out before us. Returning to Jackson, we get ready for a two day expedition to Yellowstone National Park.

**Day 4 Geysers, Bears and Wolves of Yellowstone**

Today we head north into Yellowstone, stopping at West Thumb and Yellowstone Lake, and viewing the eruption of Old Faithful Geyser. Guided by expert naturalists, we get the inside story of the amazing volcanic history

of Yellowstone, and its tremendous wildlife. After setting up camp at Madison, we visit the Bear and Wolf Discovery Center, and observe a wolf pack and grizzly bears. Tonight we have an unforgettable evening under the stars, including a flashlight night hike, weather permitting.

**Day 5 Mammoth Hot Springs & Lamar Valley Safari**

Rising early for breakfast, we get to the Lamar Valley in time for a wildlife viewing safari. Famous for bison, wolves, bears and moose, we set up scopes for close-up looks. The Lamar Valley was where bison were protected from extinction, and re-introduced into the wild. It is also home to an active pack of gray wolves. After a picnic lunch, it's off to world famous Mammoth Hot Springs, where we explore the steaming hot mineral terraces. Back at camp, we swap stories and roast marshmallows around a campfire.

**Day 6 Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone & the Falls**

This morning we pack up our camp and head to the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone River. Famous for its colorful yellow cliffs and thundering Yellowstone Falls, we explore by trail and observe the wildlife of the area. This afternoon, we say farewell to Yellowstone and journey back to Jackson for dinner and a final evening celebration.

**Day 7 Last Day in the Tetons and Return Home**

This morning we pack up, take part in closing activities, and then it is off to the airport to catch our flights home.
